Water Distribution Network Upgrade - Phase 1 Town of Stewiacke

Sealed tenders for the Town of Stewiacke Water Distribution Network Upgrade - Phase 1, plainly marked as to content, will be received at the Town of Stewiacke Town Hall, 295 George Street, Stewiacke, up to 2:00 p.m., local time, October 1, 2001 and will be publicly opened at 2:05 p.m. the same day.

The work generally includes, but is not limited to:

1. Supply of all labour, materials and equipment to supply and install approximately 3100 m of Ductile Iron or PVC watermain piping between the existing storage reservoir and the CNR crossing in the Town of Stewiacke.
2. Installation of hydrants, valves and fittings and restoration of surface finishes.
3. Modifications of the high lift pumping system at the water treatment plant.
4. Installation of a Pressure Reducing Chamber on Asquith Street.

Contract documents may be obtained from the offices of Dillon Consulting Limited as of September 25, 2001. Documents will be provided to prospective tenderers upon the receipt of non-refundable fee in the form of a cash or certified cheque in the amount of \$50.00 payable to the Town of Stewiacke for purchase of the documents. Firms must have purchased documents or their tender will be considered invalid.

Drawings and Specifications of the proposed work may be examined at the office of the Town of Stewiacke Town Hall, Dillon Consulting Limited, 137 Chain Lake Drive, Halifax and the Construction Association of Nova Scotia, 260 Brownlow Avenue in Dartmouth.

Each tender must be accompanied by a certified cheque or Bid Bond from an acceptable bonding company payable to the Town of Stewiacke for ten percent (10%) of the tender sum and a Consent of Surety for the required fifty percent (50%) Performance Bond and fifty percent (50%) Labour and Material Bond.

The Town reserves the right to reject any or all tenders, not necessarily accept the lowest tender, or to accept any tender which it may consider to be in its best interest. The Town also reserves the right to waive formality, informality or technicality in any tender.

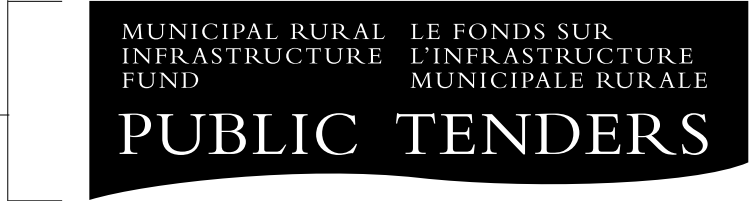

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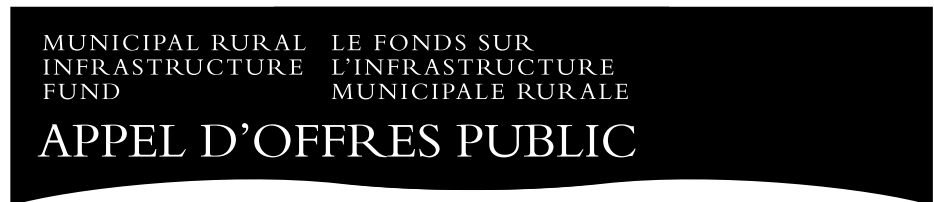
